THE MINISTER'S DESK

Welcome to week five in Epiphany. The week Luke's gospel speaks to us of catching people through the story where Jesus calls his first disciples. I often look back over the week and am astonished to see Christ's presence amongst us. I am often surprised at God's timing, generosity and risk taking. Sometimes I see it in the most ordinary of tasks, sometimes in the grandest. Jesus never fails to astound, surprise and humble me just, as I imagine, he did Simon Peter after the generous haul of fish by the Lake of Gennesaret so long ago. I wonder if you also have these moments of amazements when you know Jesus is present and calling you to continue following him.

I think we captured and passed on something of that feeling this week as the Surf Coast UC delivered morning tea baskets to our local schools. Generous and unexpected giving such as this tends to evoke feelings of amazement in the recipients. The note from Torquay Coast Primary school said, "This kind of generous gesture was very much appreciated. It was a lovely idea. Please pass on our gratitude [Sic]."

Indeed, I do pass on theirs, and my own, gratitude for your generous contribution. All that was quite astounding. But it comes back to God doesn't it? The timing, generosity and the risk. May you find time this week to risk offering astounding generosity and give glory to God for it.
