Births, Deaths and Marriages

This week we celebrate the' birthday' and 'marriage' of the Uniting Church which came into being on 22 June 1977, after three denominations - Congregational Union in Australia, the Methodist Church of Australasia, and the Presbyterian Church of Australia - joined together.

In uniting, the members of those bodies testified to "that unity which is both Christ's gift and will for the Church"

Ecumenism remains a vital aspect in all of the Church's life and work - in local congregations, national commitments to work together with other churches, and relationships and partnerships with churches of various denominations in Asia and the Pacific.

But we cannot forget the ordinary cycle of life which encompasses our people and our churches, and means we often have to address death and dying. Our response to the end of life should be handled with the same preparation and planning as the start. For those who are opening this conversation with family and friends, there are a number of useful resources available.

One available on-line resource is Dying Matters which can be found at www.dyingmatters.org. The "My Funeral Wishes" pages provide an excellent start to thinking about the issues and choices you can make to ensure your Christian faith is personally represented at your funeral and celebration of your life. The website calls this 'your last act of kindness', leaving clear and personal instructions for your family, thus taking away some of the stress involved for them as they handle life without you.

And, of course, at any time, talk to our Reverend Suzie, or other trusted Ministers within our Surfcoast churches.
