This event will be led by the Rev Sue Townsend and is a follow-up to the presentation by Rev Dr Geoff Thompson on same-gender marriage.

While the first meeting focused on the theology of same-gender marriage, Sue will lead a more interactive session, involving the lived experiences of gay Christians. She will share her Biblical understanding of the way God has created us all to be the people we are.

Sue holds a Bachelor of Ministries and an Advanced Diploma in Theology and was Minister of the Gembrook Uniting Church for four years, before taking up a pastor's position with the Melbourne Metropolitan Community Church.

During the lead up to the Australian postal vote on same gender marriage, Sue was sought after by the media as a respected spokesperson for the gay community.

Sue and her wife, Kath, are much loved swallows of the Aireys Inlet congregation where Sue has taken many discussion-style worship services.

This promises to be an excellent event, and everyone is strongly encouraged to attend – no matter your opinion on this subject. It will be a time to ask questions, share thoughts, listen respectfully to others and consider your position on this important social and spiritual issue.
