# Reflection on Isaiah 65

"For I am about to create new heavens and a new earth; the former things shall not be remembered or come to mind. But be glad and rejoice forever in what I am creating; for I am about to create Jerusalem as a joy, and its people as a delight."

Sometimes I dream that everyone has what they need: that the land is worked by those who cherish it; that food finds it way to stomachs and not land-fill sites; that young and old live and are loved well.

Sometimes I wish that children were born out of and into love; that people grew old through care not in it; that all would weep together out of compassion and not in pain.

Sometimes I imagine that heaven and earth are turned on their heads and the weight of the world hangs lightly in the air to dissipate like a passing cloud while the earth is touched only by gentleness and joy.

Sometimes I believe that there is a time and a moment in time and a holiness in the moment when the past leaves us behind and heaven happens. Sometimes a moment is all we need.

May her moment with us be a blessing and may Alexandra continue to be blessed in her service to Christ Jesus.


