This Sunday we will share together Holy Communion in an online format. If you are joining in this time of Communion, you will find the liturgy included below.

Dear All,

Before the time of the service you will want to prepare a slice or a small loaf of any kind of bread to share and a cup or small cups of juice — perhaps grape or cranberry — or wine, with or without alcohol. Set these elements in the living room or kitchen where you experience worship electronically with our faith community. Perhaps you want to put them on a lovely cloth or fabric that reminds you of a special time or person. Perhaps light a candle or place a flower or the photograph of someone you wish to bring into the circle of faith beside the bread and the cup. My voice will be heard throughout the liturgy as I participate as 'leader' and the peoples' 'unison'. I see this as participating with and as one of you. Thank you for your preparation. Please know that you do not have to participate in online Communion due to the challenge it poses to your theology on how the sacrament is to be received. For those who will be present, I seek a blessing upon each and everyone of you. I also seek feedback on how you feel about sharing in this sacrament online.

Prayer of Consecration

Leader: We have bread and cup and heart. Our church community is dispersed in distance but we are one in Christ. In your many kitchens, and living rooms, rest your hands lightly upon these elements which we set aside today to be a sacrament. Let us together ask God's blessing upon them and upon us and upon those who are in our prayers this day.

Unison:

Gentle Host, you prepare a table before us in the threatening presence of virus. You anoint our hearts, bless our bread and our cups overflow. Surely as we shelter in this place we find both the goodness of community and mercy to those most vulnerable. Now and all the days of our lives we claim that this house — these many houses where we dwell and also our precious church building, are, indeed, the house of God.

Send your Spirit of life and love, power and blessing upon your children who are staying at home so that this Bread may be broken and gathered in love and this Cup poured out to give hope to all. Risen Christ, live in us, that we may live in you. Breathe in us, that we may breathe in you. Amen.
