



If you need an excuse to pack a picnic and jump in the car, try a trip to **Steiglitz Historical Park** in the Brisbane Ranges, less than an hour's easy drive from Geelong. There is plenty to see in the historic goldfield town, with well placed signs and picnic tables. Stop at Maude on the way through at the **Bunjil Lookout** - great views, very good toilets and picnic tables.

The Courthouse (pictured below) is open on Sundays 1 to 4pm. It is a lovely building & would have many stories to tell.



If you like to get a bit more active, try the Brisbane Ranges National Park which has different walks and even camping areas and an amazing range of wildlife and fauna. Check the website beforehand as some carparks are closed for winter maintenance.
