A Pray Scarf was presented to Bill McKenzie by the Prayer Shawl group this week. Blessings sent in a beautiful cosy way.




Roma Julian has made facemasks for anyone interested. They are \$2.00 each with all funds going to the Church.


Here's the latest in the build. Roof on the back now and looking pretty good.
