I valued how he straddled Catholic virtues and reformed them to bring about his stunning concept of what is it to be in Christian community. He swears like a Texan brick labourer because he was one. He is humble, unapologetic and focused. If you are interested in following up, I recommend beginning with 'Hanna's Child' so you get become familiar with his life, faith and thought.
