It is with sadness that Colin Arthur, a long time member of the Anglesea congregation and a great supporter of the life of the Surf Coast Parish, has recently passed away. Colin grew up and lived in Blackburn belonging to another tradition, but became a member of the Uniting Church on his retirement to Anglesea many years ago. As an accountant and a meticulous record keeper, he brought his skills to the various positions he held. In 1994 Colin became secretary of the Camp Committee which administered the Burnside Camp at Anglesea on behalf of the Presbytery. He was to remain Secretary for over 20 years and oversaw the transformation of the camp and its operation. Fittingly one of the dormitory blocks at the camp is named the Colin Arthur Wing. As well as carrying out many administrative tasks, Colin was always hands-on at working bees, not just at Anglesea but across the Parish. Colin was also for many years the Presbytery representative of the Anglesea congregation. He was a good and faithful servant. Thank you Colin.
