### Thoughts for the Second Week of Lent.

#### Conflict.

A conflict is a clash of interest. The basis of conflict may vary, but it is always a part of society. Basis of conflict may be personal, racial, class, caste, political and international. Conflict is accepted by most people today, whether it be a simple issue, such as complaining about poor service, bad language, poor quality, umpires decisions, excessive cost, casting a slur, or insult against another person, because of some characteristic which varies from what is normally accepted, or at the other extreme, conflict between nations, where tens of thousands of people may be killed, or whole cities destroyed.

In virtually all cases, conflict results from someone or some people being dissatisfied with what they have experienced, with their expectations not being met, or unjust rules or regulations. Not happy!

The great danger is that the bad feelings resulting from conflict will develop into anger, and perhaps even planned or unintended acts of violence, including domestic violence, causing injury or even death. The Christian attitude must be to forgive any act of conflict, to turn the other cheek, to not retaliate!
