The first meeting of the Working group to look into the **Management of the resources of the Surf Coast**Congregations to achieve God's Mission in our communities with the Rev Suzie Castle remaining in a full time position of ministry was held on Tuesday 13th April.

We have given this group a catchy name "Forward in Faith" (FIF) which speaks of the commitment this group has to ensure we can continue to support full time ministry in the Surf Coast and share God's love within our area and beyond.

We have begun by naming 5 ways in which this can be achieved.

- 1. Stewardship... which is suggested to occur in the months of August and September.
- 2. Review the Financial structure of the SCLC and churches.
- 3. Op shop possibilities.
- 4. Fundraising
- Grants

The minimum current cost for a minister as per publication from the UCA Synod of Vic/Tas is \$108,015.30 With an average increase of 1.75% annually.

To grow and not worry about finances we need to be creative and work together to increase our funds.

This group will now go and investigate the possibilities and meet again in 2 weeks. We hope to have this finalised by October 2021.






