In the early 1990's I heard **Heather O'Connor** speak on environmental issues. She was the first woman appointed by the Whitlam government in the 1970's as an advisor on women's affairs. Heather had resigned from the position after a short while, stating that she could not advise on women's issues when she was chauffeur driven everywhere and never saw a supermarket!

Recently returned from Europe, Heather was upset about the permanent affect that the Chernobyl nuclear accident had had on the European food chain. Before it was too late, she wanted to urge Australians, to start protecting the unique environment that we have here. Heather felt that the way to do this would be to travel around Australia speaking and inspiring smaller groups of influential people such as kindergarten mums, to teach their children.

Heather's words totally inspired me and I have since tried to put these words into practise in my own life. "If we thought about change on a global level we would give up because of the enormity of the task. However, if we realised that each one of us has a unique sphere of interest to act locally and if we all did that, change can happen."

This brings me to prayer. God has given us the means to create a change for good, wherever we are placed in this world at any time. Because of the resurrection of Jesus, we are not alone. His life is in us through his Holy Spirit.


