At the end of August, we begin our Surfcoast stewardship program which will include praising God, celebrating each other, sharing our talents and giving thanks for our faith and God's faithfulness to us.

That's our life really. Praising God, loving others and sharing what we have. These three aspects of the Christian faith are what drew me to the Church because they made sense of life. Romantic idea maybe, but that's what I see over and again in our congregations. People earnestly praising, loving and serving. These three aspects of Church warm our hearts and build us up in our Christ community so we are strengthened to serve, or tend to our families, friends and the community around us. You all make wonderful disciples and bless many through your relentless pursuit of justice and words of encouragement, humility and joy.

The interesting discovery I made early in returning to regular Church, was the grief so many live with every day. Grief because of the death of loved ones, death of grand dreams, lost friendships, lost time, missed opportunities to be seen and heard, missed opportunities to achieve goals or be in a different head and heart space by a certain age. I discovered that grief, regret and loss have a significant impact on our thinking and being and sometimes our faith in Jesus. These other three aspects of being a human being, changes things for us and how we see other people, even beloved family members. Our sore or aching hearts can take a hold of us and turn us in a different direction to that of following God's will. Especially if you have been injured or harmed by another person or experience. How does anyone ever shift the heaviness of hurt and hopelessness from grief, regret and loss?

We all have different ways of emptying the *junk* that fills up our beautiful hearts and heads. But I also discovered how this *junk* doesn't always need to direct us. We can offer the grief or regret and loss to Jesus, to enable us to move toward healing and peace. This Sunday at Aireys Inlet and Bellbrae we are offering the opportunity to symbolically let go of the junk filling up hearts. We do this through a *hand washing* ceremony that you are invited to join if you choose. The same will be offered at Torquay the following week. May your week ahead be one of praise and love and sharing. **Or**, receiving praise and love from another – because you see, to accept love and sharing from someone, is an act of grace, an opportunity for others to minister.

And have a blessed day Olive on your 100th birthday knowing you have blessed so many over your lifetime.








Take the National Reading Survey
