**CALLING ALL KNITTERS: UNITING** needs rugs and blankets, so if you can knit a square, the Beaut Beanies group will sew them together and make warm coverings for those who need them. 20cm



squares are needed—use 8ply wool, any colour, and 4mm (8) needles (adjust for your knit style). Cast on 40 stitches and cast off at **20cm.** Must be done by Completion Date: 31 October.
