### **Dreaming on the winds of Change**

Albert Einstein said that 'Imagination is more important than Knowledge'. I wonder how much time we let our imagination and dreaming to inform us or to allow us to see more possibilities.

It has been said in the church that we suffer from WADITW (We've always done it that way). Sometimes it does us good to do a bit of dreaming and really use our imagination to help us think about the future of the church.



Three years ago, the Presbytery of Western Victoria embarked on a cruise to engage together in an exercise to see what the Presbytery might look like from 2019 onwards. Significant outcomes were achieved on the cruise.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> December the Presbytery gathered again to think about then issues facing the church, many of which could not have been foreseen 3 years ago. **This time we sailed on the Winds of Change.** The image of St Columba heading off into the unknown on the winds of the Spirit was our inspiration. This was day one of a 2-day event, the second day will be held early in 2022.

Our day on the Winds of Change was facilitated by the Rev Dr Jenny Byrnes. 46 members of the Presbytery gathered together in Stawell to see where the winds would take us.

To help us in preparation members of Presbytery we asked to reflect on a four page document prepared by the Presbytery Leadership Team that outlined some of the challenges ahead, some of the wisdom of the Basis of Union and some thoughts on pour current reality.

We arrived at 5 broad topics that we decided to focus on:

Who we are.

Community – looking outwards.

Community – the Presbytery as community.

Resourcing – Property/green/fit for purpose

Resourcing – People – education, leadership

When we meet again early in 2022 we hope that we will be heading into these broader topics and that we will be able to reimagine how as church we can move forward with confidence as God's people with a vision that is clear. We hope that as Presbytery we can inspire and love our congregations. We are sailing on the Winds of Change and where the Spirit leads us is the adventure offered to us, should we choose to accept it.

### **Christians United for Afghanistan - Uniting Church Support**

The Uniting Church has joined other Christians in Australia calling for urgent action by signing onto the call for Christians United for Afghanistan. This call joins your own Christian voice to the sector wide calls, and asks our Australian Government to follow the lead of Canada, in offering 20,000 additional resettlement places for refugees fleeing Afghanistan, to provide security for Afghani's in Australia on temporary protection visas or in detention, and to increase our humanitarian aid for refugees and asylum seekers in the region.

provide some asynchronous Bible study content for our members with a focus on what would be coming up in the lectionary for the upcoming Sunday. Rev Ann and I met faithfully via zoom to record our conversations about what we found interesting from the readings, with plenty of wondering questions and room for thinking about how it applies for us in our everyday walk with Jesus, not as preachers or pastors, but as followers and practitioners of the way. We recorded almost every week and I have some recordings we made which I didn't end up getting edited and online – so a back catalogue will grow with the missing weeks! Occasional we didn't publish and episode as navigating life during covid conditions wasn't always the easiest. The missing episodes were met with messages, emails and calls from people in the pews and outside the church. This was both humbling and delightful as we began to realise that a small organic initiative for our own members had much further reach than we anticipated. Since July 4<sup>th</sup> 2021 Rev Ann has been on long service leave and I have enjoyed the company, voices and wisdom of many colleagues in ministry (both lay and ordained). It has truly become a highlight of my week to sit across the virtual coffee table with cuppa in hand and speak about scripture, our understanding of God and deepening my own connection with Jesus.
