From FIF to GIFT...

Our 2021 Linked Council working party, Forward in Faith, is delighted that we have been able to secure our financial situation and continue to employ a full-time minister – for this year at least.

However, we all know that our congregations will not remain viable if we are not growing.

We now have a God-given opportunity to pause and reflect on what we want for the future of our three Surf Coast churches.

Therefore we are recommending to the Linked Congregations Council that a new sub-group be formed under the name *Growing in Faith Together (GIFT)*.

In the same way people came together for FIF, we propose that volunteers (no less than two, no more than three) from each congregation make up this new group, along with the Minister.

GIFT will need to meet to decide on its aims and a plan of action. The role of the group will be to resource and equip the three congregations and to support and learn from each other.

The main impetus for this program for change must come from within each congregation, and each will do it in their own way.

Please pray for discernment as to how God is leading your congregations and how you might be personally involved. Volunteers for GIFT should contact Suzie or their Linked Council representatives.
