Sage's Chicken—this recipe comes from excellent cook, Robin
Purdey and was available along with bunches of fresh sage at the
Trading Table last week. Thank you Robin. The dish was delish!

8 boneless chicken thighs (tenderloins work just as well)

- 1 cup plain yoghurt
- 1 & ½ teaspoons dry mustard
- 1 TBSP fresh sage chopped
- 1 TBSP lemon juice
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 cup plain breadcrumbs (or panko)
- 4 tablespoons grated parmesan cheese
- 60 gm butter, melted, S&P to taste

Mix together yoghurt, mustard, sage, lemon juice, garlic, S&P

Add chicken and coat well

Cover and marinate overnight (or at least 6 hours)
Remove chicken, roll in breadcrumb/cheese mix
Place in buttered oven dish and sprinkle over extra
crumbs

Pour over melted butter
Bake in a moderate oven for 45
mins

Serve with fresh sage, vegetables rice and/or a salad
