A COMMENT ON FAITH by Maxine Flakemore



Faith is a term mentioned a lot in everyday life. The dictionary lists 7 different uses of faith. Commonly, people refer to faith as, belief in something despite lacking any evidence for it.

The bible states in the book of **Hebrews 11: 1**, "faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things unseen." The whole chapter goes on to list the many examples of faith without sight, over centuries, starting with Abraham. **Gen: 15:6.** In this passage we learn that the central feature of faith means to place your complete trust in God having confidence that He will fulfill His promises, as Abraham demonstrated so faithfully.

In **James 2:17**, is the statement that "Faith apart from works is dead." It's no good having faith if you're not prepared to do something about it. The obedience that pleases God comes only from faith, Romans1:4-5, 16:25-26, rather than just a sense of duty or obligation, faith is important because it brings us into a relationship with God.

Ephesians 2:8 states: "For by grace (God's love) you have been saved, through faith." Faith is the only way we can receive the benefits that Jesus earned for us. Jesus lived a life of perfect obedience to God and bore the punishment for the sins of humankind on the cross.

By putting our faith in Him, we receive forgiveness for our sins, the gift of eternal life and faith with sight. (An awakening within.)

This is a simple statement but also very complex. It seems like the easiest thing in the world to do and yet....It requires a step in faith, with unwavering belief (a change of heart), to become action..... BUT......Only the infilling of the Holy Spirit, God's gift to us through Jesus' sacrifice, can make this possible.

We can theorise and intellectualise about faith but it simply remains dormant, until we individually take the step to believe and act. *That, remains the eternal mystery of faith.*

Throughout history the church has been challenged with change many times. The Uniting Church at the moment is working through a process dubbed 'Sustainable Gardens'. Options are presented with flowery language and wording that can be confusing. No changes can ever really occur however, without the inspiration and infilling of the Holy Spirit in people's hearts. In this time of challenge in our church, answers to all challenges will only come, as we individually seek a refreshing of our faith in God and a trust in Him alone.

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God" Ephesians 2:8
