Immersing ourselves in Lent 2023

Lent derives from the Old English word *Lencten*, which simply means the season of spring. (Literally, the days "lengthen"). It is that time of year when, in the Northern Hemisphere, snows melt, the light returns and new foliage begins to bloom.

Nature is alive again! The winter sleep is ended. Just as nature awakens to growth and new life, each Lent season issues a renewed invitation to us to awaken to the mystery of life, the mystery of God, the mystery of love. Just because our seasons don't match, is no reason to ignore the messages of Lent.



Right here and now, in this present moment of our lives with all its joys, worries, anxieties and fears, Jesus knocks at the door of our hearts. He waits with courtesy. There is no forced entry here, just the invitation, 'Come apart and rest awhile' (Mark 6:30).

Will I listen to this invitation? The choice is always ours!


The call to discipleship lies at the heart of the Gospel and the season of Lent beckons to us once again to 'rend our hearts, not our clothing.' The Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving foster one purpose: that we might bare our hearts before God, and pray that whatever falseness is within us may be removed.

Lent calls us to return to the truth, to re-connect with and centre on Jesus' life, suffering, death and resurrection. Pondering his life, we look not solely on our personal lives but on our interconnection with the lives of all our brothers and sisters and all creation.

Lent causes us to stop and ask: Where have I been missing the mark? Where have the connections with self, others, creation and with Jesus become severed? What choices have led to this disconnection? Where am I being called to return to the Lord?

Lent brings a fresh invitation from Jesus, to put our feet into his footprints and let him lead.

O God, open our lips;
and our mouth shall proclaim your praise.
Blessed are you, Sovereign God;
you brought life out of death
and hope from despair
when you raised our Lord from the grave.
Your Spirit ignites our hearts
with baptismal fire;
you raise us with Christ in newness of life,
inviting us to reflect his glory for ever.
Blessed is God's holy name.


