

It is time to listen to the voices of our Aboriginal people, learn about their customs and hear their concerns. Miriam-Rose Ungunmerr-Baumann, an aboriginal elder in the Daly region of Australia, has said, "There is a rich indigenous gift. It is the greatest gift, we aboriginals, can give to fellow Australians. It is called Dadirri. It is inner deep listening and quiet stillawareness." Come and hear more about Dadirri and Aboriginal spirituality. Have a chance to experience the practise of Dadirri on a short walk in the beautiful Distillery Creek National Park. Meet at the Distillery Creek picnic ground. The short walk is flat and is suitable for all fitness levels.

A REPORT FOR THOSE UNABLE TO BE PRESENT TO FAREWELL JEAN MURRAY AND BERNIE LONG.

On Tuesday 11th of July, several members from each of our linked congregations, gathered at Anglesea church at 11am, to farewell Bernie Long and again at Belmont UC to farewell Jean Murray at 2.30pm. Both Bernie and Jean have been much loved visitors to us over the years, through leading worship.

They were both people with a simple faith who lived their lives in humble service to their Lord. They departed from us on the same day, in different places and only a few hours apart. At each of their separate services their favourite reading was read. For both, it was John 14: verses 1-4

We came to know Jean in the mid 1990's, when she served as a congregational lay assistant during the tenure of the Reverends Jim Foley and Murray Little. Jean was instrumental in leading monthly worship and ministry to Elloura, which she continued on a voluntary basis long after her term of paid ministry service had ended. She was a faithful visitor to all those people at home and started the regular dine out group, which continues today.

Jean's whole life has been dedicated to the service of others. The Reverend Kevin Yelverton who led the service, said he felt that Jean's life could be best described as. "A Saintly one, living amongst us representing Christ and quietly, serving."

Bernie also represented a simple faith and remained faithful to his Lord all his life. He was a man of wit and humour whose life revolved around the four Fs, Faith, family, footy and fishing. The Reverend Paul Stephens who conducted the service told us that Bernie never worked from notes. Instead, he told stories and challenged people. He was at his best when he had challenged someone to an argument. His son in the eulogy said," Bye Dad, try not to argue with God too much."

We have really been blessed to have known both of them in our lives.
