Giving Hope on the Coast

It is so exciting to, at last, have a confirmed travel itinerary for our refugee family – they will be arriving in Aireys Inlet on the 28th of October after the long journey from Trinidad. Our planning for their arrival can now begin in earnest.

We have been truly blessed to secure a fully furnished house at a modest rent, so do not need any additional furniture.

The mother is absolutely thrilled to, at last, be on her way, four years after she fled her homeland of Venezuela. She is particularly anxious for her children, 11 year old twins, a boy and a girl, to be able to resume their education.

For more information about why families such as this have been forced to leave their country, see the following information from Amnesty International. Amnesty International about Venezuela.

As of May this year, there has been an exodus of 7.32 million from Venezuela since 2014. The people have inadequate supplies of food, water and medical supplies, there is harsh repression of dissent, including arbitrary detention and torture, violent crime is widespread and women are particularly vulnerable. The country has the second highest murder rate in the world.



We say farewell to an old friend: Vale Dr Margaret Murdoch 11.3.1936 to 28.8.2023

Several of our Surf Coast Uniting community attended a memorial service at Anglesea Uniting Church, conducted by Rev. Kevin Yelverton, to commemorate the remarkable life of Margaret. Her life was inspiring and interesting, despite many personal challenges. Margaret was a person of deep faith and conviction, who was greatly loved by her family. She lived her whole life in service to others and when growing up, nurtured her three younger siblings for many years, living in a mission school in Scotland, whilst her parents served on a mission in Africa. An immigrant from Scotland, she was the first female doctor in Sunshine, where she specialised in Obstetrics and delivered many of the Western suburbs babies whilst also raising her young family and supporting her husband. Retiring to Anglesea she joined the church and with her thick Scottish accent, she became a much loved, regular volunteer at Bellbrae op shop. The Anglesea church was packed with family and friends from Melbourne and there was only one seat left vacant. During the service, Kevin noted the fact that the seat that had been left vacant for no particular reason, just happened to be the seat that Margaret had sat in every week. I'm always amazed when I attend the funeral of someone I have known, only to discover that I never really knew much about them.
