## **GIVING HOPE ON THE COAST REPORT**

It's been such a pleasure to finally greet our refugee family from Venezuela. Yaritza, Jhon and Camila still managed to have huge smiles on their faces when they arrived in Melbourne two weeks ago, after a 40 hour journey from Trinidad – the country where they took refuge after having to flee their home country four years ago.

Thank you to everyone at Torquay who gave the family such a warm welcome at the recent combined service — on only their second day in Australia. They have since joined us for worship at Aireys and enjoyed the relaxed vibe. We happened to be blessing prayer shawls that morning, so we took the opportunity to present one each to Yaritza and the children



Activities the family took part in during their first week included "trick or treating" with the local children for Halloween and our Lunch at the Pub on Friday, where Yaritza brought a traditional dessert to share. The family visited the Aireys Inlet School Fair on the weekend – the school donated wrist bands for the children, and they took full advantage of their unlimited rides.

The family are Spanish speakers and have very little English. Priorities for the support group have been keeping the family fed and warm, opening a bank account for Yaritza, getting her Centrelink payments started, orientating them in the town, shopping for food and essential needs for the house, getting school uniforms for the children, setting up English lessons for Yaritza and exploring employment options for her. She says she will go "loco" stuck in the house!

This week Camila and Jhon are attending the Aireys Inlet Primary School for half days, building up to full days next week. They have
 been given a very warm welcome by the school and Yaritza is already in the grade parents' WhatsApp group.

Jhon has been very keen to hit the surf – an activity we have given him lots of warnings about. At last the weather has been good enough for them to dip in the ocean, but they found it rather cold. The children are also enthusiastic about the idea of owning a dog – we are encouraging offering their services to walk local dogs as a starting point.

Thanks again to all of our wonderful Surf Coast UC people for your encouragement and support with this ambitious venture.
