- Powerful singing as 100 people joined together, led by a small band and group of singers.
- New things introduced.... A service of Saturday, Electives,
 A welcome dinner(see photo sitting on grass) and a very impressive
 App used to share messages, proposals, reports... everything.
- Noticing the changes over the years, with Synod being even more diverse. First and second peoples, sharing stories, struggles and disappointments post referendum. Larger representation of Tongan, Indonesian and LGBTIQA communities. Such diversity.
- Leadership challenges for the whole church with discussions about the future structure of the UCA. People and properties, an ongoing concern.
- Inspiring Bible studies and guest speakers, including the
 Moderator Rev David Fotherington and Moderator-elect Rev Salesi Faupula. (See photo to Right.)
- A Tribute service with members recognising those who have celebrated milestones since ordination and those who have died since the last Synod meeting . **This included our own Rev Bernie Long**
- Some proposals included adopting a health based approach to drug use, and supporting the concept of secure work.

 Another proposal considered aims to address the issue of climate change, with all councils, churches, members urged to aim for zero emissions by 2040.

On 25 November, the Christmas tree in Oak Tree Place will be raised and with this the opportunity for all folk to bring items for the Uniting Christmas hampers.


Small items of toiletries, Packed biscuits, **Christmas treats and gifts.**No wrapping please. Please help if you are able.
