## **Palm Sunday**

### This is Holy Week

Palm Sunday in Jerusalem. It's an unforgettable experience—to join the huge procession, thronged with pilgrims from a host of countries, all in bright colours reflecting the spring sunshine and singing in scores of languages—but all united in full—throated Hosannas.

They walk, they swing and sing and wave their Palm branches across the top of the Mount of Olives and down the slope through the Garden of Gethsemane and then up towards the narrow Gate into the city.

Yes, its unforgettable but very different from that first Palm Sunday, when Jesus rode on a donkey's back down that same steep slope... and into what was to be a hostile city......

And still today we watch the spiralling hostilities with no one able to answer the fervent prayer of Jesus for the things that make peace.

" Would that even today you knew the things that make for peace! But now they are hid from your eyes."

### **Prayer for today**

O God our Father and Mother, we rejoice in the thrill of Palm Sunday. We see again the bright colours of that triumphant spring day; we hear the shouts of Hosanna; we wave palm branches in unison with the children of Jerusalem. Yet, we know that joy can be short-lived, that a crowd is often fickle; and that we are part of that fickleness.

Forgive our broken loyalty. Make us true followers of Jesus, each day of this coming Holy Week, that as we walk the way of his cross, we may commit ourselves all over again to the fashioning of his Kingdom... in our own communities and across your world.


